

“The Girdle of Truth”

Ephesians 6:10-14

Introduction: Christians are at war with Satan! He is our enemy. The Bible says that he is a 1) Deceiver, 2) Divider, 3) Destroyer. His ultimate goal is to cast you into hell. God has provided Spiritual Armor that you can use to fight Satan, but you must take it and use it!

The first part of armor is not truly armor at all. It is a girdle or belt of truth. It is a very basic part of what a soldier wears. It holds weapons, awards, and it binds the clothes and the armor together.

The best way to deal with the “Deceiver” is with the “Truth!”

1. “We Need To Know The Truth” (John 8:32: Ephesians 1:15-17)

2. “We Need To Use The Truth” (Matthew 4: 4, 7, 10)

3. “We Need To Live The Truth” (III John 3-4)

Conclusion: The Christian needs to be real! Not a pretender. Many 2nd Generation Christians know how to play the game, but they need to be the real deal. We stand on the Truth found in God’s Word. Not on our feelings, or desires, or thoughts, or creeds. If we are not real then the Deceiver, Satan, can worm his way in to our lives and defeat us. “Put on the

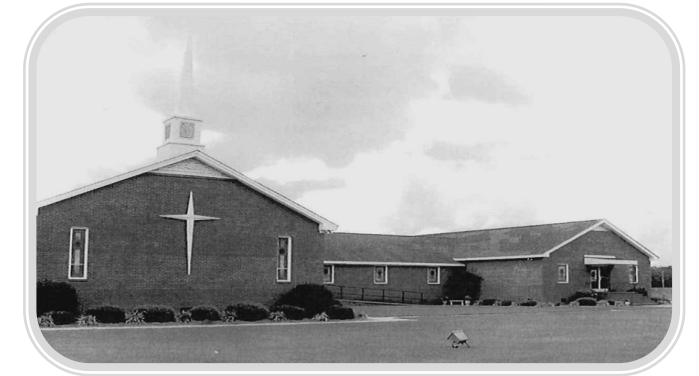

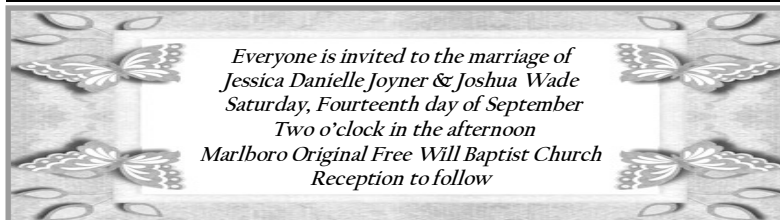
